De Kwaadsteniet Training & Co processes your personal data because you make use of our services and/or because you provide these data to us yourself. Below you will find an overview of the personal data we process:

Special and/or sensitive personal data that we process

This website and/or service does not process any special and/or sensitive personal data.

Purpose and basis to process personal data

De Kwaadsteniet Training & Co only processes your personal data in order to be able to call or e-mail you if this is necessary to perform our services.

Automated decision making

De Kwaadsteniet Training & Co does not make decisions on the basis of automated processing on matters that may have (significant) consequences for individuals. These are decisions that are made by computer programs or systems, without a person (for example an employee of De Kwaadsteniet Training & Co) in between.

How long we retain personal data

De Kwaadsteniet Training & Co does not keep your personal data longer than is strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which your data are collected. We use a retention period of two years for the above mentioned personal data.

Sharing personal data with third parties

De Kwaadsteniet Training & Co only provides to third parties and only if this is necessary for the execution of our agreement with you or to comply with a legal obligation.

Cookies, or similar techniques, that we use

Kwaadsteniet Training & Co only uses analytical cookies that do not infringe your privacy. A cookie is a small text file that is stored on your computer, tablet or smartphone the first time you visit this website. The cookies we use are necessary for the technical operation of the website and for your ease of use. They ensure that the website works properly and remember, for example, your preferred settings. They also enable us to optimize our website. You can unsubscribe from cookies by setting your internet browser in such a way that it no longer stores cookies. In addition, you can also delete all information previously stored in your browser settings.

Viewing, adjusting or deleting data

You have the right to view, correct or delete your personal data. In addition, you have the right to withdraw your consent for the data processing or to object to the processing of your personal data by De Kwaadsteniet Training & Co and you have the right to data transfer. This means that you can submit a request to us to send the personal details that we have in our possession in a computer file to you or another organization named by you.

You can send a request for viewing, adjusting or deleting your personal data or a request to withdraw your consent or objection to the processing of your personal data to info@josefiendekwaadsteniet.nl.

To ensure that the request for inspection has been made by you, we ask you to enclose a copy of your proof of identity with the request. In this copy, make your passport photo, MRZ (machine readable zone, the strip with numbers at the bottom of the passport), passport number and Burgerservicenummer (BSN) black. This is to protect your privacy. We will respond to your request as soon as possible, but within four weeks.
